To: All Participants of the **Old Salem Farm Spring Horse Shows** RE: Code Compliant Extension Cord Use will be enforced by The Town of North Salem Building Inspector/ Fire Marshal. All electrical cords must adhere to the **New York State Building Code.**

Extension cord use guidelines-

- 1) No lamp cord type extension cord allowed
- 2) Cords (rated for hard usage or extra hard usage) may be buried underground
- 3) All cords shall be listed for wet locations
- 4) Do not overload cords (amps X volts = watts)
- 5) Discard frayed cords, cords with missing grounds, or cut/damaged cords
- 6) Refrigerators, freezers, and microwaves, as well as any other heavy load equipment requires heavier cords, and should not be plugged into an outlet strip
- 7) Unplug cords or equipment when not being used
- 8) Circuit breaker to area will be shut off if cords/connections don't comply
- 9) Cords Protection cords may be arranged to avoid a tripping hazard and shall be permitted to be covered with a non-conductive matting
