



The Leading Hunter Rider Award will be given to the rider who accumulates the most points in the two Old Salem Farm Horse Shows in the following hunter divisions: Green Hunter, Green Conformation Hunter (not including model), Performance Hunter, High Performance Hunter and High Performance Conformation Hunter (not including model). These points will be based on Championship Charts totals from each show and added for a rider's overall total score. If a rider exhibits more than one horse in a division, only the horse with the most points will count towards their total. If division has fewer than 5 horses, that division will not count. The cash prizes will be awarded to the top three riders as follows:

Membership and Participation Requirements (additional specifications @ USHJA.ORG)

- A. Riders, owners, and trainers must be current Active members of USEF and USHJA to participate in this class. (see GR202).
- B. Horses and ponies must be registered with USHJA to participate in this class.
- C. Exception: Foreign residents and horses and ponies in good standing with their National Federation are eligible to compete in this class but will not receive points unless they follow I.A. and I.B.
- D. USHJA Zone HOTY bonus points will only be awarded if the owner is a current Active member of USEF and USHJA and the horse is recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA.
- E. Money won will only count for any USHJA National Hunter Derby standings or awards if the rider, owner and trainer are current Active members of USEF and USHJA, and the horse is registered with USHJA.
- F. Competition management is required to run the class if there are twelve (12) or more entries. They may choose to run the class with fewer than twelve (12) entries.
- G. Competing in the USHJA National Hunter Derby does not qualify a horse or rider for the USHJA International Hunter Derby Championship.
- H. Horses entered in this class will NOT be required to jog for soundness. Any unsoundness during the competition will be reflected in the scores from the judges (GR 1033.6).
- I. In accordance with HU146.14 the same horse-and-rider combination must compete in both rounds of the National Hunter Derby.

Schooling: During the two rounds of the National Hunter Derby all horses must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas only. Riders must wear their official horse show back number while mounted.

A minimum of twelve (12) entries, including horses tied for 12th place, must return for Round Two, if available.

Attire: Formal dress attire is suggested but not required: Buff breeches and Shad belly. White breeches and dark or scarlet coat, hunt colors, or official sponsor or team jacket permitted.

This class will be run in accordance will all rules stated in HU189. You may log on to www.ushja.org for more information.

Round One: Hunter Classic Course

- a. A minimum of ten obstacles must be offered in the Hunter Classic Round.
- b. Fence heights 3'0"
- c. There must be four option fences set at 3'5".
- d. At least one In and Out
- e. At least one Bending Line
- f. At least one line with an unrelated distance
- g. At least one long approach
- h. Jumps

Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course must offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed.

Round Two: Handy Hunter Course

- a. A minimum of eight obstacles must be offered in the Handy Hunter Round.
- b. Fence height 3'0"
- c. There must be four option fences set at 3'5"

The course should simulate riding over hunt country and must have a minimum of two handy options, such as: tight turns, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 2'6" in height, walk over an obstacle not to exceed 18" in height, lead over an obstacle, halt and/or back, open gate while mounted. Gimmicky options are not appropriate.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and the course must offer a variety of Derby jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed. A minimum 2" difference is required for the back element of an obstacle. Ground lines are not to exceed 18" in depth from the vertical plane of the jump. For appropriate jumps, no ground line is necessary. The jumpable portion of any obstacle must be a minimum of eight feet on its front face.

Classic Hunter Style Round (First Round): A minimum of 10 obstacles must be offered in the Classic Hunter Style Round. Fences must be set at 3'6 to 4'0" in height, exception option fences. The course must include higher height option fences set at a minimum of 4' in height. The number of higher height option fences cannot exceed four and the jump cups on those fences must be normal deep cups of 25-30 mm. If there is a difference in difficulty between any two tracks containing height options, the higher options should include the more inviting obstacles and be on the less difficult track. At least one in and out. At least one bending line. At least one line with an unrelated distance. At least one fence with a long approach.

Handy Hunter Round (Second Round): A minimum of eight obstacles must be offered in the Handy Hunter Round. Fences must be set at 3'6" to 4'0" in height, exception option fences. The course must include higher height option fences set at a minimum of 4' in height. (See Star System for further details.). The number of higher height option fences cannot exceed four and the jump cups on those fences must be normal deep cups of 25-30 mm. If there is a difference in difficulty between any two tracks containing height options, the higher options should include the more inviting obstacles and be on the less difficult track. The course should simulate riding over hunt country and must include a minimum of three of the following handy options: tight turn options, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 3'0" in height, execute a walk fence while mounted not to exceed 12" in height. Leading over an obstacle and opening and/or closing a gate(s) while mounted or not mounted is not permitted. Gimmicky options are not appropriate. Unless the prize list states that more than 12 entries are to return for the second round, then only the top 12 horses from the first round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for the second round.

Jump-Off Round: A minimum of eight obstacles must be offered in the jump-off round. Fences must be set at 3'6' to 4'0" in height, exception option fences. The course must include higher height option fences set at a minimum of 4' in height. (See Star System for further details.) The number of higher height option fences cannot exceed four and the jump cups on those fences must be normal deep cups of 25-30 mm. If there is a difference in difficulty between any two tracks containing height options, the higher options should include the more inviting obstacles and be on the less difficult track. The course should simulate riding over hunt country and must include a minimum of two of the following handy options: tight turn options, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 3'0" in height, execute a walk fence while mounted not to exceed 12" in height, halt and/or back. Leading over an obstacle and opening and/or closing a gate(s) while mounted or not mounted are not permitted. Gimmicky options are not appropriate.

Stabling: All horses competing in the Derby must be on competition grounds a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the derby. Jog: All horses entered in the International Hunter Derby class must jog for soundness during the Official Jog prior to the start of the first round in order to compete. The Official Jog must be held within 12 hours of the start of the first round. This jog will be run in a manner similar to an FEI jog.

A horse must be officially entered in the class before it will be allowed to jog. All horses must be presented at the Official Jog with their actual competition number and wearing a conventional hunter bridle, including noseband.

The judging panel for the Official Jog shall consist of the competition veterinarian and a minimum of one judge from the judging panels officiating for the class.

The jog surface must be level. Horses shall be evaluated from the side and following consultation with the veterinarian, the decision of the participating judge(s) is final and binding and not subject to further appeal of any kind.

If a horse does not pass the jog; the exhibitor may request to re-present the horse to the judge(s). The judge(s) may decide to allow the horse to re-present at any time up to one hour prior to the start of the class. The vet and one of the judges from the original panel must be present.

Proper attire is required (i.e., riding clothes or proper attire which an exhibitor would wear to compete in a model class).

Class Specifications - Rider can show no more than four horses. Horses entered in this class are not required to show in any other hunter or jumper classes at the horse show.



Ties: Ties involving first place shall be jumped off. For all other ties, time taken to complete the first round will decide, unless otherwise stated.

Time Allowed: Time allowed based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute.

Attire: All riders in Grand Prix Field Classes are requested to wear jackets (except Schooling Jumper) and formal attire is requested for the Low Children's/Adult Jumper Classic, Children's Jumper Classic, Adult Amateur Jumper Classic, Junior Jumper Low Classic, Amateur Owner Jumper Low Classic, Junior/Amateur Owner Medium Classic, Junior/Amateur Owner Jumper High Classic and required for the Old Salem Grand Prix, Old Salem Farm Speed Derby, Welcome Stake of North Salem, Old Salem Farm Jumper Stake, Empire State Grand Prix, and New York Welcome Stake, and the Old Salem Speed Stake.

Courses: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: brush; gates; planks; liverpools; panels; oxers; post and rails; coops; walls and natural obstacles including ditch; bank and water.

Poling & Animal Welfare: Manual poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, in the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of incident and forfeit all entry fees. Further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at this Show. All incidents will be reported by USEF Steward to the USEF for possible further investigations.

Old Salem Farm Spring Horse Shows EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS/PROTOCOLS

- 1) ALL HORSES BEING BROUGHT ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OF OLD SALEM FARM MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A "STATEMENT OF HEALTH" PRIOR TO UNLOADING.
 - a) The "Statement of Health" must be signed and dated by a Licensed Veterinarian within seven (7) days of arrival of Old Salem Farm Show grounds.
 - b) The "Statement of Health" must show that the following horse:
 - 1) Been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days.
 - 2) Have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 within the past 28 days.
 - 3) Have not been exposed to any horses or ponies that have been treated for or shown symptoms of EHV-1 within the past 28 days.

- 3) Horses traveling from other than New York State require a Certificate of Health.







RULES AND REGULATIONS

All FEI classes run in accordance with FEI Rules and according to the FEI Definite Schedule USEF posted on www.oldsalemfarm.net.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current usef rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All measurement cards, amateur cards, necessary association numbers and signatures must appear on all entry blanks, accompanied by a form of payment, before any entry will be processed and rider number given out.

- 1. Entries close Monday, April 12, 2021 5 pm, for the Old Salem Farm Horse Shows. Entries accepted after the closing date will be considered late and be charged \$100. Late entries are not guaranteed acceptance. Entries on HorseShowsOnline.com only: For your safety and to reduce paperwork and streamline office work, all entries must be done on HorseShowsOnline. com for Old Salem Farm Spring Horse Shows. Paper entries will not be accepted. Entries must be done for each week and will require the \$95 office/deposit fee to be paid. Payments will not be reversed, credited to other bills, moved, etc. Please ensure the correct payment method is used for each entry. Classes should be entered in advance to help us plan your schedules. Add Scratches will only be done through mobile. horseshowsonline.com. Office visits must be short and limited to one representative per barn. eBills will be sent out on Sunday to the Invoice Payer defined in the online entries. If you have an office manager who pays the customers bills, they should be sent there, if they customers pay, email and cell phone number will be required at the time of entry. Trainers can receive PDFs of all of their customers' invoices on Saturday evening for review and changes first thing Sunday morning. Credit cards accepted Visa, Mastercard and American Express. Credit Card payments will be charged a 3.75 percent convenience fee.
- 2. A Ship-In fee of \$90.00 will be assessed to those entries who are showing but not purchasing a stall. This is a one-time fee.
- 3. Temporary stabling available: Premium and FEI \$375 per stall, which must be paid in full by the closing date of entries. Stalls are under tents and are vinyl type with doors. No initial bedding provided. Stabling is limited, so Management reserves the right to limit the number of tack and/or grooming stalls assigned. Due to strict fire regulations, NO EXTENSION CORDS ALLOWED! No refunds on stalls after the closing date of entries. NYS Sales tax will be charged where applicable.
- 4. USEF IHP Fees: All Riders competing in any FEI sanctioned class are subject to USEF International High Performance rule see USEF GR 207 for fees due to the Federation and will be paid as part of the total FEI fee.
- 5. FEI Registration Fees: All horses and riders competing in the FEI recognized competition must have a FEI Rider Registration Number and a Horse Registration Number. Go to www.usef.org.
- 6. Stable & Schooling: FEI competitors refer to the draft schedule. All other exhibitors, early arrivals prior to May 10th 12:00 noon, must contact Stable Manager to make check in arrangements.
- 7. Scratches: Hunter and Equitation Horses: Once past the closing date of entries, horses may be scratched by written notice to the Show Secretary one hour prior to the start of the section being scratched. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes in which they are entered will forfeit their entry fees. Once a horse has shown, in order to qualify for a refund of individual "Per Class" entries, a scratch sheet must be filled out and presented to the Show Secretary accompanied by a certificate signed by the Show Veterinarian. Once a horse has shown in any one class of a division which requires a "Division Only" entry, division fees will not be refunded. When this process is complete, the class entry fee will be refunded or credited less a \$95.00 office fee.

Nominated jumpers: Once past the closing date of entries, horses may be scratched by written notice to the Show Secretary one hour prior to the classes being scratched. Nomination fee and class entry fee will be refunded or credited less a \$95.00 office fee. No refunds on stalls after the closing date of entries.

- 8. Ring dimensions and footing: Hedge Ring 140' x 250', June Road Ring 150' x 250', Indoor Ring 114' x 195'; Footing in all rings and schooling areas is drainage mats, sand and fibermix. Grand Prix Field 350' x 450', footing bluegrass mix turf.
- 9. Poling & Animal Welfare: Manual poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, in the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of incident and forfeit all entry fees. Further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at this Show.

All incidents will be reported by USEF Stewards to the USEF for possible further investigations.

- 10. Formal attire for Hunter classes: scarlet, black or dark blue coat; white shirt with white stock, tie, or choker; white, buff, or canary breeches; hunt cap, derby or hunting silk hat. Formal attire for Jumper classes: scarlet, black, dark blue or dark green coat; white shirt with white stock, tie or choker; white, fawn or canary breeches; hunt cap; black or brown boots. Hard hats must be worn at all times while riding and juniors must wear protective headgear in accordance with USEF Rules.
- 11. Prize money will be mailed in the form of a check, **made payable to the owner or other designee listed on the entry blank**, no later than 30 days after the last show day. A U. S. Social Security or Federal ID number is required before any prize money will be paid. Checks void after 60 days and the Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check.
- 10. A fine of \$100.00 plus collection fees, will be assessed for all non-negotiable checks. Foreign competitors are required to pay in US funds to avoid discount charges.
- 12. The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any class if entries warrant or the rules of the USEF require it. The Management also reserves the right to: limit the number of entries accepted, which will be done on a first come, first serve basis; change the location of any classes and to alter courses and/or fences if necessary; to decline any entry before the start of the show without being liable for compensation; change the start times of any ring from what is indicated on time schedule.
- 13. The Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by Mandatory Line which will be indicated on course diagrams and posted at least one hour before the class is to begin. Jumping orders will be established in accordance with USEF JP112 where the horses names will be drawn individually starting with the first position then working down. Riders who have conflicts should see the Starters so that necessary adjustments can be made.
- 14. Parking provided on the Show grounds only in areas designated by Management. Campers, motor homes and trailers cannot be accommodated on the Show grounds. Except for "day-trippers", horse trailers, vans, etc. will be allowed on the grounds only for loading and unloading.
- 15. No Dogs or other pets allowed on the grounds unless they are leashed and under control. Unrestrained pets will be impounded and released only upon payment of a \$100.00 fine.
- 16. Equine Health Requirements/Protocols: All horses (competing or not) that enter the grounds must have available for inspection: Negative

Coggins within one year (required) and a statement of health signed and dated by a licensed veterinarian within 7 days of arrival of Old Salem Farm Show Grounds. The statement of health must show the horse/pony has been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. The statement of health must state that the horse/pony have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 in the past 28 days nor has been exposed to any horse/pony being treated for or show symptoms of EHV-1. Horses traveling from other than New York State require a certificate of health. Every animal entered for competition or on the show grounds, shall be under the control of the Horse Show Management. Old Salem Farm, its owners, employees, agents, show committee and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property, which may occur for any reason during the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold Old Salem Farm, its owners, agents, employees and the USEF blameless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.

17. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the decision of the Horse Show Management shall be final and adhered to by the agreement of a signed entry blank.

18. All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter divisions must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers are released. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.

19. Federation Entry agreement By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Old Salem Farm (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Showpass registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.




