FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Old Salem Farm . I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable -casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Unless otherwise specified, Hunter Champion and Reserve Champion titles will be awarded to two of the four horses or ponies which have acquired the most points in over fences classes. In addition to these points, only those horses or ponies shall receive points for under saddle classes and half points for model. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF HU149.
2. Additional classes may be added to any entry, without penalty, by 5pm the night before. .
3. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary.
4. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
5. Management reserves the right to decline any entry of persons suspended or expelled from the Federation. Management reserves the right to decline any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior at Licensed Competition or towards its management, which management is able to substantiate, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Licensed Competition which management is able to substantiate.
6. MANAGEMENT, THE COMMITTEE, AND/OR OLD SALEM FARM WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT WHICH MAY OCCUR TO ANY EXHIBITOR, OWNER, ATTENDANT, HORSE OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW.
7. Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decisions shall be final.
8. All protests will be handled in accordance with USEF GR603.
9. Rotating Jump orders will be posted at all rings as needed. Exhibitors failing to appear at their designated time will be eliminated. In the event of a conflict, notify all starters involved and one ring will wait a maximum of 3 minutes for you to appear and show.
10. Management reserves the right to cancel any class if the required entries have not been received, and to combine any division if necessary, to change any obstacle or alter any course.
11. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
12. Prize money will be mailed no later than 30 days from last day of horse show.. se allow Any credit balance will be paid to the owner of record (unless we are notified otherwise in writing) within 30 days of the show. All refund checks must be cashed within 60 days.
13. Eight Ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted.
14. In jumper classes, ties involving first place must be jumped off. Ties for other than first place will be decided by time taken in the first round.
15. Management reserves the right to limit the courtesy circle with a dotted line.
16. A fee of \$75.00 will be charged for all returned checks or disputed credit cards. The horse show reserves the right to require guaranteed funds from exhibitors.
17. All dogs must be on a leash. Owners whose dogs are caught in or near any competition ring will be charged \$100.00 or the entry fee for the class in progress, whichever is greater.
18. NO ADDS TO A CLASS AFTER IT HAS STARTED.

19. USEF approved headgear must be worn when mounted while on the showgrounds.
20. Social Security or taxpayer I.D. numbers, as well as a signed, open check, will be required in the show office before any horse numbers may be picked up.
21. No stall requests will be accepted without full payment, open check or CC Form.
22. All hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness, unless otherwise noted.
23. SCHOOLING OVER FENCES in the show rings is prohibited at all times! Ample jumps in the appropriate areas will be provided for schooling. Hours for schooling on the flat will be posted.
24. POLING: MANUAL POLING of any horse or pony OR the use of a bamboo offset is PROHIBITED at all times while on the show grounds. Horses in violation will be suspended from showing for a period of 24 hours from the time of the incident.
25. All exhibitors are required to present proof of current USEF and USHJA membership, or pay the \$30 per organization show pass fees. If showing in amateur restricted classes, exhibitors must provide proof of current USEF amateur status. All horses must provide proof of USHJA Registration or pay the \$30 fee.
26. Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of waste or be subject to \$100 fine.
27. Ticketed Warmup, as scheduled, time permitting, @\$25/round. Number must be worn.

Entries and stalls will be limited as necessary and will be taken on a paid, first-come, first-serve basis.

Late entries will be accepted at an additional charge of \$35.00 per entry if received prior to the day of first class. Late entries received the day they show will pay a late entry fee of \$50.00. Stalls w/doors available at \$300.00 for temporary stalls under tents on a paid, first-come, first-serve basis. Stall fees are not refundable. Office fee is non-refundable.

307. ARIAT NATIONAL ADULT MEDAL

Open to all Amateur members of the USEF or Equine Canada who are eligible to compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter Section at this show. Additionally, a rider may not compete at the same horse show in any hunter or equitation class in which the jumps exceed three feet, three inches (3'3") or any jumper class set at 1.20m or higher, except the USHJA National Hunter Derby . To be shown over a minimum of eight fences not to exceed 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. An Open Numerical Scoring System is used in the first round.

Equine Health Requirements/Protocols: All horses (competing or not) that enter the grounds must have available for inspection: Negative Coggins within one year (required) and a statement of health signed and dated by a licensed veterinarian within 7 days of arrival of Old Salem Farm Show Grounds. The statement of health must show the horse/pony has been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. The statement of health must state that the horse/pony have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 in the past 28 days nor has been exposed to any horse/pony being treated for or show symptoms of EHV-1. Horses traveling from other than New York State require a certificate of health

A. Riders, owners, and trainers must be current Active members of USEF and USHJA to participate in this class.

B. Horses and ponies must be registered with USHJA to participate in this class.

C. Exception: Foreign residents and horses and ponies in good standing with their National Federation are eligible to compete in this class but will not receive points unless they follow I.A. and I.B.

D. USHJA Zone HOTY bonus points will only be awarded if the owner is a current Active member of USEF and USHJA and the horse is recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA.

E. Money won will only count for any USHJA National Hunter Derby standings or awards if the rider, owner and trainer are current Active members of USEF and USHJA, and the horse is

F. registered with USHJA.

G. Competition management is required to run the class if there are twelve (12) or more entries. They may choose to run the class with fewer than twelve (12) entries.

H. Competing in the USHJA National Hunter Derby does not qualify a horse or rider for the USHJA International Hunter Derby Championship.

I. Horses entered in this class will NOT be required to jog for soundness. Any unsoundness during the competition will be reflected in the scores from the judges (GR1033.6).

J. In accordance with HU146.14 the same horse-and-rider combination must compete in both rounds of the National Hunter Derby.

Schooling: During the two rounds of the National Hunter Derby all horses must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas only. Riders must wear their official horse show back number while mounted.

A minimum of twelve (12) entries, including horses tied for 12th place, must return for Round Two, if available.

Attire: Formal dress attire is suggested but not required: Buff breeches and Shad belly. White breeches and dark or scarlet coat, hunt colors, or official sponsor or team jacket permitted.

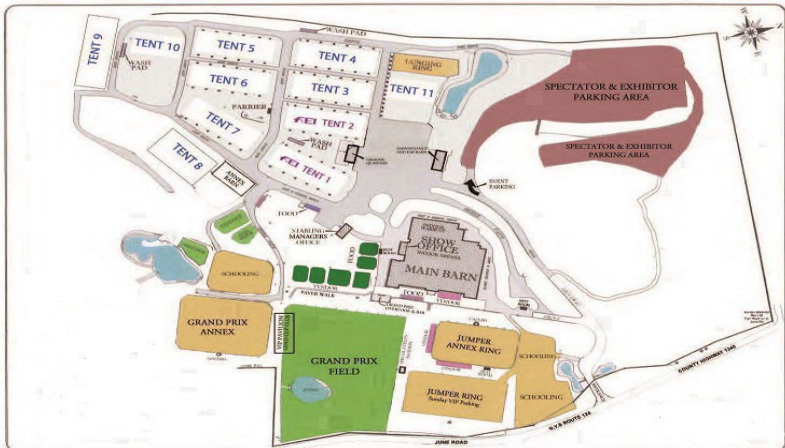

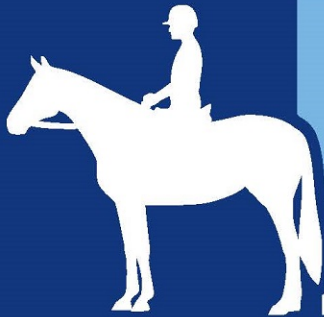
