

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current usef rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All measurement cards, amateur cards, necessary association numbers and signatures must appear on all entry blanks, accompanied by a form of payment, before any entry will be processed and rider number given out.

- 1. Entries close August 28, for the Old Salem Farm Horse Shows. All entries received after August 28, 2023 will be considered late and be charged \$100.00 per late entry. No phone entries will be accepted. No faxed entries will be accepted. Stall fees must be paid by the closing date of entries. Credit Cards accepted Visa, Master Card and American Express. Credit card payments will be charged a 4% convenience fee. For prize list and horse show information from 9:00 AM-5:00 PM: Phone (914) 669-5610. Every entry will be charged a \$95 office fee.
- 2. A Ship-In fee of \$75.00 will be assessed to those entries who are showing but not purchasing a stall. This is a one-time fee.
- 3. Temporary stabling available: Stalls \$325, which must be paid in full by the closing date of entries. Stalls are under tents and are vinyl type with doors. No initial bedding provided. Stabling is limited, so Management reserves the right to limit the number of tack and/or grooming stalls assigned. Due to strict fire regulations, NO EXTENSION CORDS ALLOWED! No refunds on stalls after the closing date of entries. NYS Sales tax will be charged where applicable. Stable flooring is grass/dirt.
- 4. USEF IHP Fees: All Riders competing in any FEI sanctioned class are subject to USEF International High Performance rule see USEF GR 207 for fees due to the Federation and will be paid as part of the total FEI fee.
- 5. Stable & Schooling: Early arrivals prior to September 11, 2023 12:00 noon, must contact Stable Manager to make check in arrangements.
- 6. Scratches: A horse scratched prior to closing of entries will receive a full refund.
- Hunter and Equitation Horses: Once past the closing date of entries, horses may be scratched by written notice to the Show Secretary one hour prior to the start of the section being scratched. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes in which they are entered will forfeit their entry fees. Once a horse has shown, in order to qualify for a refund of individual "Per Class" entries, a scratch sheet must be filled out and presented to the Show Secretary accompanied by a certificate signed by the Show Veterinarian. Once a horse has shown in any one class of a division which requires a "Division Only" entry, division fees will not be refunded. When this process is complete, the class entry fee will be refunded or credited less a \$95.00 office fee. Nominated jumpers: Once past the closing date of entries, horses may be scratched by written notice to the Show Secretary one hour prior to the classes being scratched. Nomination fee and class entry fee will be refunded or credited less a \$95.00 office fee. No refunds on stalls after the closing date of entries.
- 7. Ring dimensions and footing: Hedge Ring 140' x 250', June Road Ring 150' x 250', Indoor Ring 114' x 195'; Footing in all rings and schooling areas is drainage mats, sand and fibermix. International Arena 350' x 450'.
- 8. Poling & Animal Welfare: Manual poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, in the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of incident and forfeit all entry fees. Further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at this Show.
- All incidents will be reported by USEF Stewards to the USEF for possible further investigations.
- 9. Formal attire for Hunter classes: scarlet, black or dark blue coat; white shirt with white stock, tie, or choker; white, buff, or canary breeches; hunt cap, derby or hunting silk hat. Formal attire for Jumper classes: scarlet, black, dark blue or dark green coat; white shirt with white stock, tie or choker; white, fawn or canary breeches; hunt cap; black or brown boots. Hard hats must be worn at all times while riding and juniors must wear protective headgear in accordance with USEF Rules.
- 10. Prize money will be mailed in the form of a check, **made payable to the owner or other designee listed on the entry blank**, no later than 30 days after the last show day. A U. S. Social Security or Federal ID number is required before any prize money will be paid. Checks void after 60 days and the Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check.
- 11. A fine of \$100.00 plus collection fees, will be assessed for all non-negotiable checks. Foreign competitors are required to pay in US funds to avoid discount charges.
- 12. The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any class if entries warrant or the rules of the USEF require it. The Management also reserves the right to: limit the number of entries accepted, which will be done on a first come, first serve basis; change the location of any classes and to alter courses and/or fences if necessary; to decline any entry before the start of the show without being liable for compensation; change the start times of any ring from what is indicated on time schedule.
- 13. The Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by Mandatory Line which will be indicated on course diagrams and posted at least one hour before the class is to begin. Jumping orders will be established in accordance with USEF JP112 where the horses names will be drawn indi-vidually starting with the first position then working down. Riders who have conflicts should see the Starters so that necessary adjustments can be made.
- 14. Parking provided on the Show grounds only in areas designated by Management. Campers, motor homes and trailers cannot be accommodated on the Show grounds. Except for "day-trippers", horse trailers, vans, etc. will be allowed on the grounds only for loading and unloading.
- 15. No Dogs or other pets allowed on the grounds unless they are leashed and under control. Unrestrained pets will be impounded and released only upon payment of a \$100.00 fine.
- 16. Equine Health Requirements/Protocols: All horses (competing or not) that enter the grounds must have available for inspection: Negative Coggins within one year (required) and a statement of health signed and dated by a licensed veterinarian within 7 days of arrival of Old Salem Farm Show Grounds. The statement of health must show the horse/pony has been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. The statement of health must state that the horse/pony have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 in the past 28 days nor has been exposed to any horse/pony being treated for or show symptoms of EHV-1. Horses traveling

from other than New York State require a certificate of health. Every animal entered for competition or on the show grounds, shall be under the control of the Horse Show Management. Old Salem Farm, its owners, employees, agents, show committee and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property, which may occur for any reason during the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold Old Salem Farm, its owners, agents, employees and the USEF blameless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.

17. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the decision of the Horse Show Management shall be final and adhered to by the agreement of a signed entry blank.

18. All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter divisions must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers are released. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.

19. Federation Entry agreement By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Old Salem Farm (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Entry Fee: \$150.00

Entries for the Regional Maclay Championship classes should be sent to Old Salem Farm on an Old Salem Farm official entry form. Enter on www.horseshowsonline. Entries are not to be sent to NHSAA.

Membership in the National Horse Show Association (NHSA) is required for all riders competing in the ASPCA Maclay and all trainers who have riders competing in the ASPCA Maclay. The membership/qualifying year is September 1 - August 31.

The National Horse Show Association of America, Limited ("NHSAA") is responsible for the organization, presentation and administration of the Maclay Trophy and the associated competitions, including the Maclay Regional Championship ("Regionals") and Maclay National Championship ("Finals") Classes. To ensure the selection of appropriate sites, judges, and course designers for the Regionals and the Finals, the NHSAA communicates with the National Horse Show Equitation Committee. USEF rules govern these competitions and the Maclay National Championship Qualifying Classes ("Maclay"). In case of any conflict between these Rules and USEF rules, USEF rules shall govern.

The course for each Maclay Regional Championship shall be designed by a USEF Course Designer, in consultation with the Regional judges, if available. The course for each Maclay Regional Championship should be of sufficient difficulty, typifying the Maclay National Championship Finals and thereby reflecting the importance of the class while keeping in mind that there will be riders of all levels and the course must be challenging but safe. Although the courses must not be identical, they should reflect equal difficulty and challenge. The course must be 3'6" with or without wings. The course must include at least two changes of direction, a combination including an oxer, and 1/3 of the obstacles must be oxers. The top element of all obstacles must be securely placed so that a slight rub will not cause a knockdown. If breakaway or safety cups are used the top cup must be the deepest standard cup available. A plank may not be used as the top element of a jump. A liverpool or water is prohibited in ASPCA Maclay classes including Regionals. In addition, all courses must include at least three of the following: bending line, narrow jump (5'6"-8'), rollback turn, fence at the end of the ring, long approach to a single jump.

A Regional competition must have at minimum 6 competitors for the class to be held. One horse per rider. Trainers/Coaches permitted to ride and school competitor's horses. Competitors do not need to declare the horse they will compete on prior to competition A rider in any Regional competition must complete the course to be eligible for invitation to the National Finals if applicable. Two refusals will eliminate a rider from Regional competition.

To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse. The Under Saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. USEF Tests 1-23.

After completion of the jumping phase, a minimum of twelve (12) riders, if available, are required to show at a walk, trot, and canter. At the sole discretion of the judges, additional flat work may be called for, but all groups must be asked to perform the same tests. No more than twenty (20) riders at a time may be asked to work together in a group. The flat performance of those riders selected to show in the flat phase shall count 50%. Changing of bit/bridle between phases is permissible. After the flat phase the Judges may request further testing using USEF tests 1-23.

Judging Conditions

Each Regionals shall have two (2) "R" Judges. It is requested that one of these judges be selected from the approved list of judges supplied by the NHSAA. The second judge is not required to be selected from this list. Judges for the Finals are ineligible to judge any Regionals in the same year. The Judges will select a Champion, Reserve Champion, and Third through Tenth place finishers at each Regionals. The Champion, Reserve Champion and Third place finisher, if not otherwise qualified, will receive invitations to compete in the ASPCA Maclay Finals and have 48 hours to respond. Only riders who have met the Maclay point requirements to compete in the Regionals are eligible. The Champion, Reserve Champion and Third place finisher from each Regional competition will be awarded National Horse Show Scholarships as follows: Champion \$1000, Reserve \$750, Third \$500.



Nominating fee: All horses showing in the Jumper Division must be nominated and must be paid by the closing date of entries for Junior, Amateur, and Open Jumpers. A rotating jump order will be established.

Declarations: Declarations must be made in the Show Office on the appropriate form by 4:00 p.m. the day before the class is to be held.

Awards: Trophy and eight ribbons awarded in every class, unless otherwise specified.

Ties: Ties involving first place shall be jumped off. For all other ties, time taken to complete the first round will decide, unless otherwise stated.

Time Allowed: Time allowed based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute.

Attire: All riders in Grand Prix Field Classes are requested to wear jackets (except Schooling Jumper) and formal attire is requested for the Children's/Adult Jumper Classic, Junior/Amateur Owner Jumper Classic, and required for the Old Salem Farm Welcome Stake, Old Salem Farm Great Oak Grand Prix and Old Salem Farm Jumper Classic.

Courses: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: brush; gates; planks; liverpools; panels; oxers; post and rails; coops; walls and natural obstacles including ditch; bank and water.

Poling & Animal Welfare: Manual poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, in the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of incident and forfeit all entry fees. Further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at this Show. All incidents will be reported by USEF Steward to the USEF for possible further investigations.

Championships: Champion and reserve will be awarded to the two horses scoring the most points in each of the following sections: Children's/Adult Jumper, Junior/Amateur Jumper.

 - a) The "Statement of Health" must be signed and dated by a Licensed Veterinarian within seven (7) days of arrival of Old Salem Farm Show grounds.
 - b) The "Statement of Health" must show that the following horse:
 - Been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days.
 - 2) Have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 within the past 28 days.
 - 3) Have not been exposed to any horses or ponies that have been treated for or shown symptoms of EHV-1 within the past 28 days.
- 2) Negative Coggins within one year.
- 3) Horses traveling from other than New York State require a Certificate of Health.

HEALTH PROTOCOLS:

Please be mindful of routine biosecurity measures to prevent any potential spread of contagious diseases

Avoid nose to nose contact between horses from different stables.

Avoid shared or communal water buckets.

NOTE: Please feel free to contact our show veterinarian with any questions regarding these requirements.

These requirements have been drafted by the management from this horse show in consultation with our show veterinarian and the New York State division of Animal Industry.

The horse show manager reserves the right to request horses be subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian in determining whether such animals are, or have been infected/exposed, or are likely to become infected with an infectious or contagious disease. All exhibitors are encouraged to review the equine health transport requirements for New York State prior to arrival. These requirements are for the safety of all horses entering the horse show facility.
