Membership and Participation Requirements (complete specifications @ USHJA.ORG)

- A. To compete in a USHJA National Hunter Derby (NHD), horses must be recorded with USEF and registered with the USHJA prior to the start of the class.
- B. To compete in an NHD, Riders, Owners and Trainers must be current active members of the USEF and USHJA prior to the start of the class.
- C. Foreign residents and horses in good standing with their National Federation are eligible to compete in an NHD but will not receive USHJA National and Zone HOTY bonus points unless they comply with Roman Numerals I.A and I.B above.
- D. The same horse may not compete in the USHJA NHD and the USHJA International Hunter Derby at the same competition.
- E. If specified in the prize list, horses entered in an NHD may be required to compete in one (1) or two (2) additional classes at the same competition.
- F. If specified in the prize list, the number of horses a rider can compete in an NHD may be limited.

Schooling

1. All horses competing in an NHD must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas during both rounds of the class. (Exception: If management designates a specific schooling area for horses competing in the NHD, all horses must be ridden in that designated schooling area during both rounds of the class.)
2. Horses that are competing in an NHD that are found being ridden or schooled in other than an official horse show schooling area, or a specific schooling area designated for the NHD during the class will be eliminated. Entry fees will be forfeited.
3. Horses that are competing in an NHD that are found being ridden or schooled by a rider NOT wearing the number assigned to that horse will be eliminated from the class. Entry Fees will be forfeited.
- B. Hand walking in the NHD arena is permitted prior to the start of the class.
- C. When appropriate, management is encouraged to allow flatting in the NHD arena.
- D. In accordance with HU 174.14 the same horse-and-rider combination must compete in both rounds of the NHD.

Competition Format

A. Traditional Format-Two Phases

1. The Classic Hunter Round
2. The Handy Hunter Round
3. Each round will be run separately.
4. All horse-and rider combinations will compete in the Classic Hunter Round.
5. The top twelve (12) horse-and-rider combinations from the Classic Hunter Round, if available and including ties for the last qualifying position, will compete in the Handy Hunter Round. (Exception: More than twelve (12) horse-and-rider combinations may compete in the Handy Hunter Round if stated in the prize list.)

Rules and Regulations

Course Specifications

- To be shown over a course of not less than 10 obstacles.
- Course must include: One combination (including an oxer), 1/3 of the obstacles must be oxers, At least two changes of direction after the first obstacle, At least 3 of the following: Bending Line, Narrow Jump (5'6"-8'), Roll back turn, Fence at the end of the ring, Long approach to a single jump, Obstacle height to be set at 3'6", Maximum width of oxers 4', Maximum width of triple bars and hogs backs 5', Liverpool's and water jumps are prohibited.

Eligibility:

The Old Salem Farm Governor's Perpetual Hunt Seat Cup 3'6" Eq Championship is open only to members of the USEF or Equine Canada who have not reached their 21st birthday in accordance with USEF EQ 111, Section 7. a, 1 and 2. Only one rider per horse. Two refusals will eliminate a rider from competition.

USEF EQ 111, Section 7. a. Definitions and Eligibility

1. Junior Rider - An individual who has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year (See GR128).
2. Young Rider - Individuals are eligible as Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year, in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21 (See GR 150).

Conventional tack per USEF EQ 106.5A Open to Junior/Young Riders who have not reached their 21st birthday under USEF rules. No schooling in the International Arena before the class. Riders to jump one round over a course of at least ten 3'6" jumps. The top ten highest scoring riders will return to jump a second round, in reverse order of placings from the first round: lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, those orders will be drawn. The overall score will be obtained by adding the score for each round. Additional testing may be required, tests 1-19. Tack requirement to meet that of the USEF EQ105.5.

3. Riders must enter class 318 by NOON Friday May 15. Rider's must attend the competition official draw on Friday May 15. This will include a reception for all competitors, their families and trainers. Location of the draw will be confirmed. Late entry will be \$3,000, and rider will be first to go in the class.

Qualifying Classes:

Riders must have competed in at least 2 - 3'6" equitation classes at either Old Salem Farm Spring Show I or Old Salem Farm Spring Show II May 5-10 or May 12-17, 2026.

Judging:

- To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. • One panel of two judges. Numerical scoring both rounds. • Preliminary Round – to be shown over course of jumps set to above stated specifications.
Course to be posted one hour before the start of the class. Order of first round based on points.
- Second Round – 20 riders will be asked to return for a final round over a second course following the above stated specifications the next day. The second-round course may include tests. Scores from first round determine order of go for second round.
- Second round score will be combined with first round score.
- No flat phase. Jumping only.
- Testing – If competitors are within 2 points of the leader, then judges must elect to test. If competitors are not within 2 points of the leader, testing will be optional. Testing of up to 6 riders using USEF tests 1-23.

Awards:

The judges will select a Champion and a Reserve Champion. Ribbons through 12th Place. \$50,000 will be awarded to top placed Rider in the form of a Scholarship and \$50,000, to be split three ways, will be awarded to the trainers of the Top3 riders.

Prize Scholarship:

In order for a Rider to receive the Scholarship, the Rider must have an open 529 Savings Plan. The Rider has the option to open a new 529 Savings Plan through a qualified administrator, or to have the Scholarship deposited into an open 529 Savings Plan established for the Rider's benefit. The Rider must open any new 529 Savings Plan within fourteen (14) days of accepting the Scholarship. The Scholarship will be fully funded to the Rider's 529 Savings Plan within thirty (30) days of the event.

The Rider and/or their parents or legal guardians may also be required to sign a release of liability, as set forth herein, prior to the distribution of the Scholarship. The recipient of the Scholarship, (or their parents or legal guardians), is bound by all rules and obligations relating to 529 Savings Plan accounts. Any disbursement of funds from a 529 Savings Plan account may only be used for those purposes as set forth in the applicable 529 Savings Plan rules and regulations. The Rider (or their parents or legal guardian) should carefully read the rules, regulations and restrictions for 529 Savings Plan accounts prior to accepting the Scholarship. Compliance with 529 Savings Plan account rules, regulations and restrictions are the responsibility of the Rider (or their parents or legal guardian). Please note that, in most cases, 529 Savings Plan funds, plus interest earned, may be released to the beneficiary at the age of 23 for use at the beneficiary's discretion. All questions regarding 529 Savings Plan accounts should be directed to a qualified financial advisor.

By accepting the Scholarship, Rider shall release, discharge and hold harmless Old Salem Acquisition Corporation d/b/a Old Salem Farm, the United States Equestrian Foundation, UBS Financial, The Kincade Group, and any of their employees, agents, owners, directors, officers, parents, subsidiaries or affiliates from any and all liability that may be imposed or associated with receipt or use of the Scholarship, and from and against any and all claims, actions, proceedings, and liability for any damages, expenses, fees, injury or losses sustained in connection with (directly or indirectly) the Scholarship or acceptance, possession, use, misuse or nonuse of the Scholarship.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All FEI classes run in accordance with FEI Rules and according to the FEI Definite Schedule USEF posted on www.oldsalemfarm.net.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current usef rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All measurement cards, amateur cards, necessary association numbers and signatures must appear on all entry blanks, accompanied by a form of payment, before any entry will be processed and rider number given out.

1. Entries close Monday, April 13, 2026 5 pm, for the Old Salem Farm Horse Shows. Entries accepted after the closing date will be considered late and be charged \$100.00. Late entries are not guaranteed acceptance. Entries on HorseShowsOnline.com only: For your safety and to reduce paperwork and streamline office work, all entries must be done on HorseShowsOnline.com for Old Salem Farm Spring Horse Shows. Paper entries will not be accepted. Entries must be done for each week and will require a \$485.00 deposit to be paid. Payments will not be reversed, credited to other bills, moved, etc. Please ensure the correct payment method is used for each entry. Classes should be entered in advance to help us plan your schedules. Add Scratches will only be done through mobile. horseshowsonline.com. Office visits must be short and limited to one representative per barn. Trainers can receive PDFs of all of their customers' invoices on Saturday evening for review and changes first thing Sunday morning. Credit cards accepted Visa, Mastercard and American Express. Credit Card payments will be charged a 4.0% convenience fee. The Office Fee is \$130.00 per entry. Ticketed Warm Up \$35.00

2. A Ship-In fee of \$140.00 will be assessed to those entries who are showing but not purchasing a stall. This is a one-time fee. Ambulance fee \$75.00.

3. **Temporary stabling available: National and FEI Tack \$485.00 per stall, which must be paid in full by the closing date of entries. Stalls are under tents and are vinyl type with doors. No initial bedding provided. Stabling is limited, so Management reserves the right to limit the number of tack and/or grooming stalls assigned. Due to strict fire regulations, NO EXTENSION CORDS ALLOWED! Stalls are non-refundable after closing date April 13, 2026. NYS Sales tax will be charged where applicable.**

4. USEF IHP Fees: All Riders competing in any FEI sanctioned class are subject to USEF International High Performance rule see USEF GR 207 for fees due to the Federation and will be paid as part of the total FEI fee.

5. FEI Registration Fees: All horses and riders competing in the FEI recognized competition must have a FEI Rider Registration Number and a Horse Registration Number. Go to www.usef.org.

6. Stable & Schooling: FEI competitors refer to the draft schedule. All other exhibitors, early arrivals prior to May 4th 12:00 noon, must contact Stable Manager to make check in arrangements. Early arrival fee: \$70 per day. Stalls will be temporary housed under canvas and stall doors provided. Stable floor is stonedust.

7. Scratches: Hunter and Equitation Horses: Once past the closing date of entries, horses may be scratched by written notice to the Show Secretary one hour prior to the start of the section being scratched. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes in which they are entered will forfeit their entry fees. Once a horse has shown, in order to qualify for a refund of individual "Per Class" entries, a scratch sheet must be filled out and presented to the Show Secretary accompanied by a certificate signed by the Show Veterinarian. Once a horse has shown in any one class of a division which requires a "Division Only" entry, division fees will not be refunded. When this process is complete, the class entry fee will be refunded or credited less a \$250.00 scratch fee. Total show scratch fee \$250.00.

Nominated jumpers: Once past the closing date of entries, horses may be scratched by written notice to the Show Secretary one hour prior to the classes being scratched. Nomination fee and class entry fee will be refunded or credited less a \$250.00 scratch fee. No refunds on stalls after the closing date of entries. Jumper Nomination Fee: \$290.00

8. Ring dimensions and footing: Hedge Ring 140' x 250', June Road Ring 150' x 250', Indoor Ring 114' x 195'; International Arena 350' x 450'; Footing in all rings and schooling areas is drainage mats, sand and fibermix.

9. Poling & Animal Welfare: Manual poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, in the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a twenty-four hour period starting from the time of incident and forfeit all entry fees. Further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at this Show.

All incidents will be reported by USEF Stewards to the USEF for possible further investigations.

10. Formal attire for Hunter classes: scarlet, black or dark blue coat; white shirt with white stock, tie, or choker; white, buff, or canary breeches; hunt cap, derby or hunting silk hat. Formal attire for Jumper classes: scarlet, black, dark blue or dark green coat; white shirt with white stock, tie or choker; white, fawn or canary breeches; hunt cap; black or brown boots. Hard hats must be worn at all times while riding and juniors must wear protective headgear in accordance with USEF Rules.

11. Prize money will be mailed in the form of a check, **made payable to the owner or other designee listed on the entry blank**, no later than 30 days after the last show day. A U. S. Social Security or Federal ID number is required before any prize money will be paid. Checks void after 60 days and are not cashed. No cash prizes. All duplicate checks are void. No cash prizes. Foreign competitors are required to pay in US funds to avoid discount charges.

12. The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any class if entries warrant or the rules of the USEF require it. The Management also reserves the right to: limit the number of entries accepted, which will be done on a first come, first serve basis; change the location of any classes and to alter courses and/or fences if necessary; to decline any entry before the start of the show without being liable for compensation; change the start times of any ring from what is indicated on time schedule.

13. The Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by Mandatory Line which will be indicated on course diagrams and posted at least one hour before the class is to begin. Jumping orders will be established in accordance with USEF JP112 where the horses names will be drawn individually starting with the first position then working down. Riders who have conflicts should see the Starters so that necessary adjustments can be made.

14. Parking provided on the Show grounds only in areas designated by Management. Campers, motor homes and trailers cannot be accommodated on the Show grounds. Except for "day-trippers", horse trailers, vans, etc. will be allowed on the grounds only for loading and unloading.

15. No Dogs or other pets allowed on the grounds unless they are leashed and under control. Unrestrained pets will be impounded and released only upon payment of a \$100.00 fine.

16. **Equine Health Requirements/Protocols: All horses (competing or not) that enter the grounds must have available for inspection: Negative Coggins within one year (required) and a statement of health signed and dated by a licensed veterinarian within 7 days of arrival of Old Salem**

Farm Show Grounds. The statement of health must show the horse/pony has been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. The statement of health must state that the horse/pony have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 in the past 28 days nor has been exposed to any horse/pony being treated for or show symptoms of EHV-1. **Horses traveling from other than New York State require a certificate of health.** Every animal entered for competition or on the show grounds, shall be under the control of the Horse Show Management. Old Salem Farm, its owners, employees, agents, show committee and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property, which may occur for any reason during the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold Old Salem Farm, its owners, agents, employees and the USEF blameless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.

17. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the decision of the Horse Show Management shall be final and adhered to by the agreement of a signed entry blank.

18. All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter divisions must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers are released. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. PLEASE INCLUDE COPIES OF MEASUREMENT CARDS WITH ENTRIES TO FACILITATE PROCESSING.

19. Federation Entry agreement By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Old Salem Farm (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

US EQUESTRIAN SAFE SPORT STATEMENT All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Old Salem Farm Spring Horse Shows **EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS/PROTOCOLS**

- 1) ALL HORSES BEING BROUGHT ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OF OLD SALEM FARM MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A “STATEMENT OF HEALTH” PRIOR TO UNLOADING.
 - a) The “Statement of Health” must be signed and dated by a Licensed Veterinarian within seven (7) days of arrival of Old Salem Farm Show grounds.
 - b) The “Statement of Health” must show that the following horse:
 - 1) Been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days.
 - 2) Have not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-1 within the past 28 days.
 - 3) Have not been exposed to any horses or ponies that have been treated for or shown symptoms of EHV-1 within the past 28 days.
- 2) Negative Coggins within one year.
- 3) Horses traveling from other than New York State require a Certificate of Health.

HEALTH PROTOCOLS:

- Please be mindful of routine biosecurity measures to prevent any potential spread of contagious diseases
- Avoid nose to nose contact between horses from different stables.
- Avoid shared or communal water buckets.

NOTE: Please feel free to contact our show veterinarian with any questions regarding these requirements.


